PURC is an annual undergraduate conference, created by Dr. Elizabeth Bjork in 1992. This conference is a great opportunity for students to conduct and develop their own research and gain the valuable experience to share and present their research to their peers and faculty. Students will present their research as posters or paper talks during the day-long event. In addition to fostering undergraduate professionalism, PURC has proved to be a meaningful and exciting forum for students from UCLA and other universities throughout the nation to communicate their research activities with one another.
